Dish	We Suggest	Why it Works
Spiral Ham	2006 Sylvaner Rancho Sisquoc Winery	This spicy, sweet white brightens the sweet and salty flavors of this classic holiday dish.
Roasted Turkey	2005 Zinfandel Reserve Charles B. Mitchell Winery	Zinfandel stands up to heavily seasoned food without competing for attention.
Prime Rib	2003 Cabernet Sauvignon Martin Weyrich	This rich wine seasons the meat with just the right amount of acid to make each bite perfect.
Roasted Lamb	2006 Pinot Noir CRU Winery	This fruity wine rounds out the gamey flavors of lamb.
Pork Chop	2005 Merlot Stevenot Winery	Together with pork chops, the merlot creates a sweet salty combination with universal appeal.
Duck Breast	2004 Syrah Gann Family Cellars	Fruity quality of syrah soften the savory, gaminess of this rich meat.
Roasted Chicken	2005 Red Rover Chardonnay Stevenot Winery	Basic roasted chicken can go with many wines, but chardonnay gives it dimension without being overpowering.
Salmon	2007 Chardonnay Chateau Julien Winery	Full flavored fish needs a big white to cut through its rich flavor without getting lost.

Huntington Wine Cellars

Based in Healdsburg, California in the heart of Sonoma County's lush and treasured wine country, is Huntington Wine Cellars. The winery, founded in 1989, was purchased by wine industry veteran Bill Leigon in 1997. With the vision of producing world-class California wines that would appeal to all of the senses and reflect the finest things in life, Bill Leigon took Huntington Wine Cellars under his wing. It was fitting then that the visual identity of Huntington included a majestic falcon on the label. Each vintage of Huntington wine boasts a unique label known as "Drinkable Art," a reproduction of a fine art piece incorporating Huntington's signature falcon, painted by artist and Huntington partner, Ken Schilling.

The Huntington wines are produced from small lots of select varietal grapes from several unique vineyard sources from throughout California. Regions including the Russian River Valley, Alexander Valley, Dry Creek Valley, Napa Valley and Central Coast are home to grapes that produce Huntington Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah and Merlot. Huntington's wines are created by the winemaking team of Kerry Damskey and Barry Gnekow. Their combined experience and connections provide insight and flexibility to source the best fruit from top vineyards and produce various varieties and blends of small wine lots with very close attention to detail. The resulting wines are complex in Huntington's signature style: uniquely identifiable, refined, elegant and understated.

California Chardonnay Sonoma County 2006

When old world meets new. Our 2006 Huntington Chardonnay offers a wonderful purity and the freshness of cool climate Chardonnay terroirs. Native yeast barrel fermentation with frequent lees stirring combined with stainless tank fermentation provides both complexity and brightness to the aromas and palate. In the mouth, ample natural acidity defines pronounced flavors of apple with a creamy and rich finish. Tasty, alluring and leaving a satisfying impression.

California Petite Sirah 2006

Subtle layers of black fruit such as berries, cherries, and plums fill the nose while spicy cinnamon and sweet cardamom scents tease the senses. The rich and full mouthfeel of this well-crafted wine is pure refined elegance supported by balanced textures and smooth acidity. From first sip through the last sip, this wine is quite simply refined.

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
